What came you here to do?

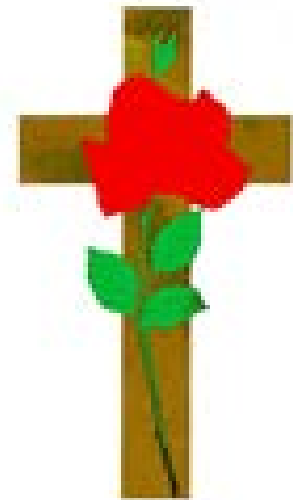
Have you studied well the meaning
